<u>SCIENCE:</u> You will also be gathering information about chemical and physical properties of mass in preparation for several labs later in the week. Be watching your landfills to see what changes are taking place in these final weeks. After planting our seedlings, the big job for the next few weeks will be to make sure the seeds are kept damp!



<u>LANGUAGE ARTS:</u> You will have a reading passage (Stitches in Time) and questions to answer which will be given to you Monday and is due Wednesday. <u>MATH:</u> This week you will be looking at some intriguing problems involving ratio and rate. Be prepared to think carefully about how relationships between two quantities can change. Towards the end of the week we will be investigating percentages which are a specific type of rate that compares something to 100. For homework this week you will have a skill sheet due Thursday and quiz corrections due Friday. You may have some additional classwork to take home if it is not completed in class.
