

<u>SCIENCE</u>: We'll be planting our seeds for our square foot garden this week as well as caring for the petunias. Our final unit centers around The Earth and Human Impact. We'll explore how the availability of natural resources is related to the Earth's processes, how natural hazards can be predicted and how humans impact all of this! Be prepared to do some hard thinking!



<u>LANGUAGE ARTS:</u> We'll continue our work with Ray Bradbury's 'The Veldt' and will be comparing the video with the written story. You'll be working with figurative language again this week as we look at the craft and structure of the text. For HW you will be given a short passage, 'The Wolf', to read and respond to in writing. This will give you additional practice using evidence from a text to support your thinking. This assignment is due Wednesday. As soon as we wrap up 'The Veldt' we'll begin exploring the art of argument writing.

<u>MATH:</u> This week we will explore the concept of percents and how they relate to fractions, decimals, and everything that we have learned about ratio and rate. There will be a short post assessment related to the pre-assessment that you completed last Friday. For homework this week you will have a fraction-decimal-percent table due on Thursday.
