SCIENCE: This week we'll continue our look at how the resources of our Earth are distributed and look in depth at their availability.

LANGUAGE ARTS: We will continue working with argument writing as we write, revise, edit and finalize our essays relating to technology and the positive and negative impacts it can have on our relationships. We'll also practice our speaking skills by having a formal debate about this topic at the end of the week. If there is time, we'll do a reader's theater!
