SCIENCE: Welcome back! This week we will return to the Design Process we talked about with the Foot Orthosis at the beginning of the year. There will be two projects to explore, one where you will plan and design a wind racer and the other involving the "Profi Cubes" you have been trying to put together! Put your thinking hat on and stay tuned for the details!
